Summary Statement

Contamination of cutlery, flatware, glassware and other kitchen utensils.	HIGH	Paper plates/boxes/cups and throw away cutlery to be provided on all transactions with no sharing of cups, cutlery with extra bins provided for disposal.	
Contamination of surfaces in high use areas such as door handles, table tops, cupboard handles, bar & kitchen equipment and light switches	HIGH	1. All handles and high use surfaces to be cleaned with anti-bacterial wipes at set out in the cleaning schedule. 2. A sign off sheet to be completed and monitored to ensure compliance.	
Contamination of training and matchday equipment such as training cones, flags and goalposts	MEDIUM	Club officials and volunteers to be allocated specific job roles to ensure limited contact of training/matchday equipment. Equipment to be cleaned	

		with anti-bacterial wipes/spray during and after use.	
Contamination of footballs used on matchdays	MEDIUM	Number of people using or handling footballs reduced, balls to be cleaned with anti-bacterial wipes before and after the game.	
Staff, players, supporters unaware of measures they can take to contain the spread of the virus	MEDIUM	1. Signage with latest government advice to be erected around the ground to encourage social distancing measures, use of hand sanitisers. 2. All board members and volunteers to be aware of guidelines and to actively “encourage” adherence with the Stadium.	
Contamination of changing rooms	MEDIUM	1. The physio table and benches to be cleaned with anti-bacterial wipes following each game 2. A visual check to be completed and monitored to ensure compliance.	
People coming into close contact with others in the Briggers Bar, changing rooms and communal areas within the Stadium	MEDIUM	1. Avoid contact and remain at least 2 metres from others where possible. 2. Do not perform a task which requires people to work together under 2m metres apart, consult the COVID-19 to find alternative ways to complete the task.	
Contamination of water bottles, glasses and cups	HIGH	1. Staff not to use other people's cups 2. Players to bring their own water bottles, or use water bottles supplied by committee, with no sharing with other players 3. Glasses in Briggers Bar to be cleaned thoroughly and encourage “throw away” options for one use only.	
Customers visiting Briggers Bar and Stadium not adhering to protective measures	MEDIUM	1. All customers to sign track and trace register and receive a briefing regarding the measures detailed in this risk assessment. 2. Amount of customers in premises must be	

		monitored by staff to avoid over crowding.	
Infection control for staff, supporters, volunteers coming to the Stadium on matchdays.	HIGH	Santiser station added to the every table in the Briggers Bar and around the stadium. All players, staff and customer to be advised and encourage to use 1. When entering bar 2. After visiting public bathrooms 3. Before eating food from Briggers Bar	
Contamination of cash handed over at ticket box and Briggers Bar	HIGH	1.Club to offer contactless payment card machines at turnstiles and Briggers Bar and option to purchase a ticket in advance of games. 2. Customers encouraged to pay by card where possible
